**Re:** PENDING STA CLEARANCES FOR NSW DUAL REGISTERED MEMBERS

Womens Bowls NSW has advised members wishing to change their Nominated Club to another STA that applications for State and Territory Association (STA) Clearances should allow 5 working days for processing.

Bowls NSW is aware that some applications which have been submitted by dual-registered female members are still awaiting to be approved and/or processed due to the increased volume received over the past few weeks.

As at 14<sup>th</sup> February 2020, a total of 844 Pennant Declarations have been received.

Bowls NSW advises Clubs that any female member who has applied to Womens Bowls NSW for either an Interstate (STA) Clearance or Interstate (STA) Pennant Declaration prior to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2020, will be eligible to compete in Bowls NSW championships events and State Pennants from this coming weekend (14<sup>th</sup> February/15<sup>th</sup> February) and will not be disadvantaged or penalized due to a delayed Pennant Declaration approval.

**PLEASE NOTE: Clubs must ensure that ALL players are registered with Bowls NSW AND listed on their respective Pennant Participation List prior to being eligible to compete in Bowls NSW Championship events and State Pennants.**

Any Bowls NSW member wishing to compete in another State or Territory for championships or Pennants should lodge an STA Clearance or Declaration with Bowls NSW prior to the event and will receive approval within 24 hours.
