- Youngest ever inductee
- Has represented Australia on many occasions between 1995 & 2002
- Commonwealth Games Silver Medallist in 2002
- Played 277 Games for NSW
- Winner of 7 State titles in Singles, Pairs and Fours. Only Charlie McNeill, Bob King and Dave Downie (fellow Hall of Fame Inductees) have won more
- Winner of Champion of Champion Pairs (96)
- Winner State Number 1 Pennants (St Johns Park)
- Winner NSW Premier League 3 times – St Johns Park, Warilla and Taren Point)
- NSW Bowler of the Year 2003
