**Re:** Strong interest and registrations for roadshows

This circular provides an update on the initial completed roadshow sessions and a reminder to register for upcoming sessions in your area.

Our Unification Roadshow is underway, and we have been encouraged by the strong interest from the New South Wales bowls community. Commencing last week, members of the Unification Working Group have been visiting clubs across the state to share the work completed to date, discuss the benefits of the unification model, and importantly answer any questions from the community. Each session has run for approximately one hour, including a 30-minute presentation and 30 minutes for questions and answers.

We have now hosted three information sessions in the Central West region, visiting Mudgee, Dubbo and Parkes. We welcomed 93 attendees across all three sessions, with representatives from 18 clubs. The atmosphere at each of these sessions was very positive, with high levels of engagement and questions being asked.

Although registration is not compulsory to attend, it is recommended, as it will assist with planning and enable us to communicate any schedule changes or venue capacity constraints.
