Re: Update on Constitution

Thank you to those that have reviewed and provided feedback on the Constitution for the new entity, Bowls New South Wales Limited. This has now been finalised and is attached to this notice for members' information.

The Constitution was developed over a number of months with significant input and oversight from the legal counsel of both BNSW and WBNSW. In addition, a structured review and feedback process was undertaken by the Unification Working Group (UWG) and both Association Boards. It has been developed using up to date and best practice knowledge from across the sports sector.

The purpose of sharing the Constitution with members has been to ensure a transparent process, and to provide an opportunity for any questions to be clarified, or issues to be raised. Given the time and work that has gone into the development, review, and refinement of the Constitution to date, there has not been any significant changes required.

The updated Constitution has been provided via email to all clubs and stakeholders, as well via a link in the Member Information and Voting Pack
